Alleluia, Christ Is Risen!

Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!!!

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ, it is good to be the Church, the Body of Christ in our time and place! I pray that your Easter Sunday celebrations were filled with the love and grace of Christ. In addition, I pray that you carry the joy of Easter beyond just one day of celebrating, throughout the entirety of your life.

Easter Sunday begins a fifty-day season of the Church year that ends on the Sunday of Pentecost. Over the course of this season, the scripture passages that are read in worship will revolve around a central theme of belonging to Christ. From the story about Thomas and his doubts to the gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, we are repeatedly reminded about our interconnected place in God's family.

As a way to illustrate this interconnectedness we have with God, I invite you picture in your mind a set of Russian nesting dolls. You know how these dolls fit one inside the other. The smaller inner ones nestled safely inside of the larger outer ones. The dolls are one unit together providing safety and meaning for the whole.

Just like nesting dolls, Jesus is within God, and we are in turn within Jesus as his sheep, his fruit of the vine, his people, his body here on earth. Just like those smaller dolls inside the larger doll, we are embraced and protected by God's love and grace at every level. We are not just with Jesus but within Jesus, as much a part of him as he is of God. We are secure in the arms of God and nothing in this world or the next can change that. This sure and certain good news calls us through the waters of our baptism into lives of sharing the good news, spreading the love of Jesus, and working for justice for all.

The season of Easter reminds us that we are to faithfully do our best to live out our baptismal callings no matter the outcome, possible missteps, questions, or doubts. We can accomplish this only because God, through Jesus, will always have a place for us in the fold or on the vine. Jesus does not ask us to be perfect, but to abide in him and bear fruit worthy of our calling. When we find our place and sense of belonging within God, we are also reminded that there are others who belong to God and that we are called to build community with them regardless of our differences.

Through the journey of the Easter season, we move from a familiar small group of disciples to a large group of people who go from only seeing their differences to being united by the Holy Spirit. It is this unity, within God and

within the body of Christ, which drives our Easter season and continues to drive our lives of faith as Christ's disciples in the world. We can do all of this because...

Christ Is Risen!

He Is Risen Indeed!!


Session One: The absolute opposites of Holy War and Pacifism (May 1)


The Quilters of Hope will be meeting Tuesdays, 10:00am to 2:30pm. Please bring a lunch and join us! No sewing experience is needed.


