

Words from Pastor Mike Parsh Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

At the celebration of Pastor Jones' ministry, we will sing Timothy Dudley-Smith's hymn *O Christ the Same*. This beautiful hymn speaks to how Christ is the same throughout all of life's passages and chapters. As I pondered the words of the hymn, I was drawn to the opening phrase of the first verse. It reads as follows:

O Christ the same, through all our story's pages, our loves and hopes, our failures and our fears; eternal Lord, the king of all the ages, unchanging still amid the passing years:1

Good Hope and Zion will participate in the annual ELCA Day of Service on Sunday, September 10, 2023. There will be a shared worship service at 10:15am at Good Hope. Lunch will be provided following worship. The following service opportunities are available, for all ages and abilities:

- Assembling personal care kits for Lutheran World Relief
- Assembling school kits for LWR
- Tying quilts for LWR (no sewing skills required)
- A community service project, to be determined

Bins will be located in the Good Hope office hallway to collect items. Below are donation opportunities for GWOH Sunday:

- Donations of non-perishable items for Community Services of Venango County
- Monetary donations to cover overseas shipping costs for quilts and kits (\$2-\$3 per item)
- Monetary donations to purchase items for the care or school kits.
- Donations of items to make **ONE COMPLETE** personal care kit
 - One light-weight, dark-colored bath towel
 - <u>Two</u> bars of bath soap (4 to 5 oz each), preferably unscented
 - One adult toothbrush
 - One sturdy comb
 - One metal nail clipper
- Donations of items to make ONE COMPLETE school kit:
 - Four 70-sheet notebooks, approximately 8" x 10 ½" (no loose-leaf paper)
 - One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with both inches and centimeters
 - One pencil sharpener
 - One pair of blunt scissors
 - Five unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers
 - Five black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink)
 - One box of 16 or 24 crayons
 - One 2 ½" eraser






