



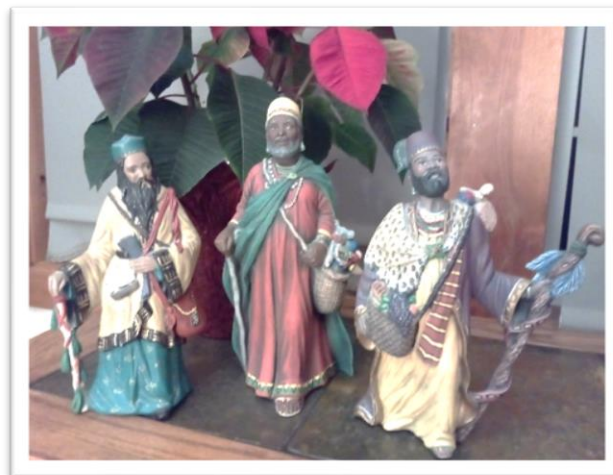

Preschool**

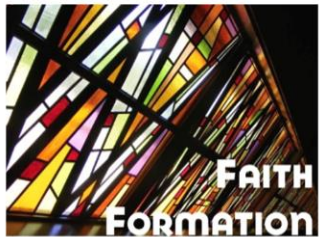
It is hard to believe it is January already. The preschool class has been working hard on the alphabet, learning Bible stories, manners, and kindergarten readiness. We've made lots of crafts plus apple sauce, butter, and salt dough ornaments.

The toddler time class has been working on socialization, Bible stories, listening skills, and language skills. They also have been making many crafts and singing with the preschool class at music time each Wednesday. Both classes enjoyed learning about the birth of Jesus. We will be talking about the Wise Men's visit and the miracles Jesus performed when we return.

**EXCITING NEWS** - Starting January 3, 2023, the preschool class families have a choice of leaving their children in our half day program or having the children stay for a full day program. This program will run from our regular start time at 8:45am and dismiss at 2:30pm. Children opting for the half day program will still dismiss at 11:15am. We are excited to be able to expand the program and offer the children a chance at some extra instruction time, more STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) opportunities and a change to ease into a full day of kindergarten with our three day a week full day program. 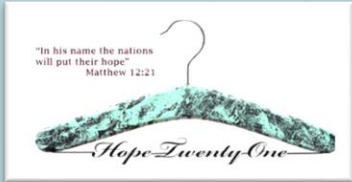


**Hope For The

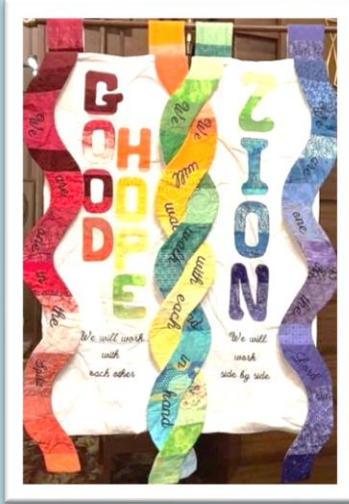
