

Words from Pastor Sandra Jones I thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you, because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now. I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ.

The Letter of Paul to the Philippians, 1:3-6

I am grateful to God, and to all of you, for the opportunity to be your pastor since September 2016 until now. We have worshiped and given praise to the LORD. We have continued to grow in our knowledge of God's Word and have celebrated the sacraments of the Christian Church that are the Means of Grace for us – Christ's presence in word, water, bread, and wine. We have shared so many joys and sorrows, always supporting one another through times of trouble. Together, we continue to reach out to our local community, addressing the needs of our neighbors in various ways. Together, we are the Church in this time and place. It has been a pleasure and a privilege to love and serve God through you and with you. I am confident that God will continue to guide you in the years to come.

When I applied to the Northeastern Iowa Synod and to Wartburg Seminary in early 1990, to be considered as a student in the Master of Divinity program, I wrote these words in an entrance essay:

The last five years [of prayer and employment in a congregation] have been a time of integrating my convictions and my actions and a time of discovering how my gifts can be used for ministry in Christ's Church. Through study and through the experiential learning the seminary offers, I think the vocational aspirations, or ways I can use my gifts in ministry, will become more clear. I can envision myself as a parish pastor or in some other area of specialized ministry, and I am open to either way of service. I have a high level of commitment and loyalty to the Church as the people of God and followers of Christ, though there are some areas of struggle I experience with the institutional church or organizational structures; the human made aspects of our life together that sometimes hinder our spirituality, faithfulness, and service.

33 years ago, I had no idea of how following a call to ordained ministry within the church was going to work out, where I'd end up living, or if I'd have enough money to pay the bills. I had no idea of God's plans or the many wonderful people, opportunities, and experiences that would bless my life.

I did learn quickly to *never say never* ("I'll never leave lowa"; "I'll never serve more than one congregation at a time"; "I'll never get married again", for example). I learned that the interruptions in daily life are when real ministry happens, and that moments of God's presence and grace (miracles!) are just out there waiting for you and for me. I learned through experience that God's adventures are even greater than those I can plan or imagine.

As we learn from Matthew's gospel readings this summer, there is a cost to discipleship. You give up things and you sacrifice. You may risk your reputation and sometimes, your relationships with people who cannot understand such a life of commitment. You may journey to new places or be required to stay put because that's where God's people need you most.

As I have shared with you before, it has all been worth it and I do not regret where God has led me. I am especially thankful that my closing years of parish ministry have been with you at Good Hope and Zion. Your support, cooperation, and Christian care have been marvelous. I do not leave this ministry with unhappiness or any form of bitterness. I close this chapter of my life story with joy and peace.

May that joy and peace be with you, now and always.


Thank You

NWPA Synod Assembly June 8-10, 2023 Alexis Dehner and Joyce Frenz represented Good Hope Lutheran Church at the first full assembly since 2019. Bishop Lozano declared the theme of the 2023 synod convention as 'I Love to Tell The Story' encouraging each and every one of us to go out and share our stories.

We elected several people to be Synod Council members: Alexis Dehner was elected to Synod Council as youth representative along with another youth from Meadville. Open committee positions were filled as well.

We heard reports from Bethesda Lutheran Services, Thiel College, United Lutheran Seminary, Luther Memorial and Woman of the ELCA. Lutheran Home at Kane did an amazing report on how they kept residents safe during the Covid-19 pandemic and Yvonne Paranick presented a report from the Green Team.

Alexis was particularly impressed by the Synod focus on spreading the good news of the gospel. She feels the synod's efforts to connect with younger people plays a vital role in that endeavor. A generous gift of \$47,000 from Mt. Calvary, Erie, was designated to youth ministry and mission within the Synod.

The Donald McCoid Order of Service award was presented to Rev. Ralph Jones, Bishop Emeritus (2020), Rev. Karen Lundwall (2021), Rev Brian Moran (2022), and Rev. Sandra Jones (2023). These servants of our church were acknowledged and thanked for their service on our behalf for the sake of the Gospel.

Bishop Lozano was awarded the medal of meritorious service by the ELCA. Pastor Jacobson presented the Bishop with a card and gift for his retirement from the US Army chaplain corps. Colonel Lozano served in Iraq and is retiring as a command chaplain from the US Army Reserves after 13 years of service.

The Worship and music portion of the Assembly was exemplary as always and we thank you for allowing us to attend as your representatives.




2023 Graduates Quilt Presentations




