God is stronger than...

Dear Sisters and brothers in Christ,

We have been on quite the journey together these past several weeks. We have and still do weep, lament, and grieve together. We also gave and give thanks to God and proclaimed the glory of Jesus' resurrection in our Easter celebrations. We have been on a journey that none of us expected to play out the way it has. And yet throughout our shared experience, we know that God is stronger than anything this world can throw at us.

The life changing good news of the resurrection of Jesus puts on full display the love of God. In this gracious act, God promises that nothing can separate us from God and that our salvation has been secured once and for all. Again, God is stronger than anything in this world, even our own sinful brokenness that Pastor Jones wrote about in the April newsletter.

As I was pondering the phrase, "God is stronger than...", I was reminded of a song I learned when I was younger. It came from the Veggie Tales series of shows that teaches basic Christian principles to children. The song that came to mind was, "God is bigger than the Boogieman." The message of this song is that God is bigger of than the scary things of this world. It helps teach children to trust that God will see them through things that frighten them. While the song is fun to sing and is appropriate for the intended age group, it paints a basic understanding of what God does in this world. As our faith grows and we encounter more of what the world can throw at us, we often find ourselves searching for deeper understanding of how God is at work in the world. And yet sometimes a simple hymn can have profound meaning for us no matter where we are at along our faith journey.

The hymn *Goodness Is Stronger than Evil* is one such hymn that has spoken to me this Easter season. It was written by Archbishop Desmond Tutu in 1995. As you may know, Tutu was a South African Anglican bishop and theologian, known for his work as an anti-apartheid and human rights activist. He was Bishop of Johannesburg from 1985 to 1986 and then Archbishop of Cape Town from 1986 to 1996, in both cases being the first black African to hold the position. Theologically, he sought to fuse ideas from black theology with African theology. From 1978 to 1985 he served as general secretary of the South African Council of Churches (SACC), a subsidiary of the World Council of Churches (WCC). The

ELCA is a member of WCC. While general secretary, SACC became a vital institution in South African spiritual and political life, voicing the ideals and aspiration of millions of South African Christians.¹

I was an ELCA Youth Gathering participant at the 2000 Youth Gathering in St. Louis where Bishop Tutu was a guest speaker. In his address, he thanked the US Lutherans and the rest of the world for standing with South Africa to end apartheid. What I remembered from his speech is that the love and goodness of God is stronger than the evils of this world.

Which brings us back to Tutu's hymn, *Goodness Is Stronger than Evil* (ELW 721). This hymn reminds us that through God's love and grace poured out for us by the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus, we can respond to this great gift by showing the world that goodness and love are stronger than evil and hate.

Sisters and brothers in Christ, through the waters of our baptism we are called to shine forth God's love and grace into our world each and every day of our earthly journey. Will this always be easy? No. Will we always get it right? No. But the good news is that God's love and grace is stronger than our weakness. With this sure knowledge, let us carry the Easter message of God's great love for all of creation out into our hurting world. We can do this all because God is stronger.






Community Ministry Committee continues to serve those in our community in many ways:

- Loads of Love distributes \$5 bundles of quarters to random local laundromats to help the community with laundry cost will soon be coming to an end as grant funding money is depleted.

We support our local teachers and emergency personnel when needed and are always looking for new ways to serve our community so if you see a need, please bring it to our attention, we may be able to help!


