

Words from Pastor Mike Parsh Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

We live in a fast-paced world. Our days are filled with any number of things like work, school, appointments, doctors, meetings, and a whole host of other things. Often, we don't get a chance to slow down and see the blessings in our lives or God's presence at work in our lives.

The writer of Psalm 105 reminds us in verse 4 to, "Keep your eyes open for God, watch for his works: be alert for signs of his presence."

In our fast-paced world we miss so much of what God wants us to see and to experience. We know and believe that God is present within us as well as all around us. We can find God at work everywhere we go. God is present in our neighbors, both near and far. God is present in the stranger we meet at the gas station. God is present in those who we would prefer to avoid. The challenge we have is to slow down and see the world through God's eyes, which is exactly what the gospel passages for this month invite us to do.

As November begins, we turn to the final month of the church year. The church year runs from the first Sunday of Advent to Christ the King Sunday. This means that the church/liturgical year does not follow the twelve month calendar that we have grown accustomed to over the centuries.

We begin this last month of the church year with All Saints Sunday. On this day we remember and give thanks to God for all of those who have gone before us in the Faith. The names of those who have died since the last All Saints Sunday will be read during worship and candles will be lit in their memory. Furthermore, we remember and celebrate that through our baptism we are joined together with all the saints.

The lectionary gospel lesson for All Saints Sunday is Matthew's Beatitudes. In this passage we hear that in God's kingdom those that the world excludes, are held in the highest regard. However, this is not some far off reality that will only be established when Christ comes again. The Beatitudes speak to us about the here and now. We are called, as were the saints before us, to live in the manner of Jesus and show God's love to all.

This theme of faithfully following Christ's call to action is a central part of the lectionary texts for the month of November. We will read Jesus' parables about bridesmaids being prepared, servants stewarding their master's wealth, and about how the sheep and the goats will be separated on the last day. These texts call us through the water of our baptism into faithful service of all of God's creation. We are called into the living out of the love of God.

by giving thanks for all material possessions, we as followers of Christ are called to give thanks for what we have and then put it into use for the betterment of all.

As the church year draws to a close, we are not to simply coast to the season of Advent. No, we are continually called forward into mission for the sake of the Gospel and to see God in all those that we encounter. We are to reflect the love of God, even when the world around us seems to be getting darker. As you move through this month, I invite you to take some time to slow down and be aware of God's presence all around you. Maybe God will surprise you with what you see.




## Semi-Annual Meeting


